Do you want to see more kids graduate from high school? Help our neighborhoods become safer for everyone? Support a friend struggling with illness or addiction? Examples of donations and the services they help make possible include:

## FOR JUST **\$2** A WEEK OR **\$100** A YEAR —



- Provide a mental health visit at a Federally Qualified Health Clinic
- Provide someone in job training with transportation to and from the training site for the length of the program and an interview-ready suit
- Provide a child with early childhood programming or preschool for a day
- Provide an hour of crisis intervention and advocacy for two victims of domestic violence and their children
- Provide healthy food for a hungry family

## FOR JUST **\$3** A WEEK OR **\$150** A YEAR —



- Provide a primary care visit at a Federally Qualified Health Clinic
- Provide coaching and transportation for ten people going on job interviews
- Provide sports equipment and art supplies for an afterschool program

## FOR JUST **\$5** A WEEK OR **\$250** A YEAR —



- Provide afterschool enrichment programming for a middle school student
- Provide an individual with financial literacy coaching and the ability to open a savings account
- Provide a professional wardrobe for someone re-entering the workforce

## FOR JUST **\$10** A WEEK OR **\$500** A YEAR —



- Provide home visiting services for a child age birth-3 for a month
- Provide 5 people with a doctor's visit
- Provide one week of violence prevention programs

## FOR JUST **\$20** A WEEK OR **\$1,000** A YEAR (a Leadership level gift) —



- Provide one week of case management related to job readiness, confidence and leadership skills to improve employment prospects
- Cover legal services for an order of protection for a victim of domestic violence or elder abuse

- Provide a year of afterschool programming for a middle school student
- Cover the cost of life and professional skills training for two individuals in an extensive employment readiness program
